Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No. 68, dated 10.03.2017, registered under Sections 379-B, 411 and 34 I.P.C., at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he, along with Shubham, was recipient/ vendee of stolen articles. A raid was conducted on the basis of secret information to the effect that Kulwant Singh and Kuldeep Singh are in the habit of selling snatched articles in the market. Kulwant Singh and Kuldeep Singh were arrested in the raid. The petitioner was not named in the secret information nor he was arrested from the spot. The petitioner was implicated only on the basis of disclosure

statements of co-accused and a mobile was allegedly recovered from him.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sub Inspector Gulshan Lal submitted that the challan has not been presented so far.

The case appears to be debatable in the context of alleged recovery made from the petitioner on the basis of disclosure statements of the co-accused.

At this stage, without meaning anything on merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail, since he is accused of offence under Section 411 I.P.C.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail, subject to his executing adequate bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
