Since the issue was pertaining to allotment of a retail outlet and in the very nature of things, the cause of action would not survive, as respondent No.4 is running the petrol pump for the last more than 25 years, coupled with the fact that nobody would be in a position to put the clock back, present appeal is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous by afflux of time.

However, liberty is granted to the appellant to get the instant appeal revived within a period of three months, if necessity arises.
