Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners no longer wish to pursue the present petition as the matter has been amicably settled with respondents no.3 to 10.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but with a direction to respondent no.2 to otherwise ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioners, as also of the private respondents, continue to be protected, within the four corners of law.

However, it is made clear that if any of the averments made in the petition is found to be incorrect, specifically with regard to either the petitioners being in any prohibited relationship to each other, or as regards their previous marital status, or with regard to their age, this order shall not

be construed to be a bar on any proceedings initiated by a competent person
as per law.
