The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.02 dated 11.04.2017, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Sections 13(i)(D) read with 13(2) 88 PC Act, registered at Police Station V.B. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Counsel appearing for the petitioners would contend that the matter has since been compromised with the complainant Jaswinder Singh/respondent No.2.

Having heard counsel for the petitioners at length and having perused the record, this Court is not inclined to entertain the instant quashing petition only on the basis of the compromise.
