ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, JUDGE (ORAL)

Petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No. 40 dated 09.03.2017 under Sections 325/323/427/148/149 IPC registered at Police station B-Division, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of the sudden fight and only simple injuries were caused to the petitioners as well as to the complainant party. The matter has now been resolved with the intervention of the respectables.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 and 3 states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 08.05.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar, dated 02.06.2017,

has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded, which indicates that they have entered into compromise without any pressure, threat or influence.

Only simple injuries are stated to have been caused in the incident and the parties want to put quietus to the litigation. In view the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 40 dated 09.03.2017 under Sections 325/323/427/148/149 IPC registered at Police station B-Division, District Amritsar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
