Petitioner-Gurdeep Singh @ Soni has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.193 dated 21.09.2016, registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, under Sections 307, 341, 427, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner has been specifically named by the complainant-injured. As per the case of prosecution, the petitioner alongwith co-accused fired on the complainant. The petitioner was stated to be armed with gun and two fire shots hit the complainant. Though, it is not specifically mentioned as to whether the shots fired by the petitioner hit the complainant-injured or not. The case is at preliminary stage.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of active role attributed to the petitioner, who armed with deadly weapon and fired from the gun alongwith co-accused etc., I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail at this stage.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
