Learned Stated counsel on instructions from ASI Jang Bahadur, Police Station, Adampur, District Jalandhar states that as a result of investigation involvement of petitioner-Ankush Tiwari in the instant case has not been found, as such, he has not been sent up to face trial. Rather in the challan filed in the Court his name figures in column No.2.

It being so, the bail application has become infructuous and is dismissed accordingly.

However, it is observed that if at any stage petitioner-Ankush
