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**RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(Oral)**

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.110 dated 08.05.2016, registered under Sections 302/120-B/212/216/148/149/201 I.P.C. and under Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Kotwali Faridkot, District Faridkot.

The F.I.R. was registered at the instance of one Kulwinder Singh, who is a fruit seller. Uncle of the complainant was involved in the business of supplying mineral water to different destinations in the city. During the course of said

business, when Devinder Singh came in front of the shop of Taini Cable Wala, where he was to meet the complainant at about 10.20 a.m., two young boys came on a motorcycle. Pillion rider opened fire at Devinder Singh and fled away from the spot. Devinder Singh was removed to the hospital, where he was declared to be dead.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he did *reki* of the site and also provided food to the persons, who were living in the house of Surjit Singh. The names of the motorcyclists came to be known as Gaurav Sharma @ Goru Bacha (pillion rider) and Harpreet Singh @ Bhooti (driver). One Avtar Singh introduced Harpreet Singh @ Kala to Surjit Singh, who in turn introduced the assailants to Surjit. The assailants along with others took the premises of Surjit Singh on rent.

The police investigation is based on the statements of Jaswinder Singh @ Bheema, Kamal Kumar and Surjit Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the alleged recovery of motorcycle was from the abandoned site, not belonging to the petitioner. The motorcycle had no number.

The petitioner is in custody since 16.05.2016.

Avtar Singh @ Gollu and Harpreet Singh @ Kala have been granted bail by this Court on 28.04.2017 in

**CRM-M No. 43819 of 2016** and **CRM-M No. 12683 of 2017.**

The aforesaid **CRM-M No. 43819 of 2016** was filed by Avtar Singh @ Gollu for grant of anticipatory bail.

In view of aforesaid, without adverting to the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
