By this petition, the petitioners seek protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of respondents no.8 to 10, who are allegedly threatening them on account of a dispute on a plot, though the petitioners have an injunction order passed in their favour by a Civil Court, a copy of which has been annexed with the petition as Annexure P-5.

Learned counsel further points to the fact that even the Adjutant of the Unit in which petitioner no.3 is posted, he being a soldier in the Army, has written to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent no.3), to investigate the case and take action as per law.

Consequently, without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the said respondent, i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent no.3), to thoroughly go into the matter, including the fact that an injunction order is shown to be existent in favour of the petitioners, and to ensure that the lives and liberty of the

petitioners are protected within the four corners of law and any action as is warranted to be taken as per law, is taken by him, within a period of one month from the date of the receipt of a certified copy of this order.
