Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 for lodging the FIR against respondent Nos.3 to 5 on the basis of complaint No.1152/DCP dated 24.04.2017 filed before Deputy Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar.

Petitioner seeks to espouse her grievance against respondent Nos.3 to 5 in the context of detaining her in the school premises for the purposes of getting signature on the cheque *qua* which litigation is pending before the competent Court.

Petitioner alleges that respondent No.3 and 4 have become executory mechanism without there being any lawful order passed by the Court.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioner has filed a complaint before the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar and the same is pending consideration before him.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Shilesh Gupta, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2. Let requisite copies of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the pleadings contained in the present petition, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is directed to take into consideration the pending complaint No.1152/DCP filed by the petitioner on 24.04.2017 and take appropriate action in accordance with law. He would be well within his right to ascertain the truth in the allegations of the petitioner, without being swayed away by any consideration in terms of pleadings or anything recorded in the preceding part of the order.

It will be appreciated, if the complaint is decided within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
