The instant petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 as they had entered into matrimony against the wishes of their elders.

Upon notice of motion having been issued, learned State counsel has filed in Court today a response by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patti, District Tarn Taran and the same is taken on record.

Perusal of the same would reveal that statements of both the petitioners have since been recorded and in which they have stated that they are living happily as a married couple at the parental house of petitioner No.2, Tarsem Singh. Petitioners have further stated in their statements that now they do not apprehend any threat from respondents Nos.4 to 6 and as such, do not

need any police protection/security.

Such development also perhaps explains non-appearance of the counsel of the petitioners today.

No further directions are required to be passed.

Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
