This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to register FIR against respondent Nos.8 and 9 under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC and to mark the inquiry on the allegations made by the petitioner to an independent agency.

The learned counsel states that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to look into the report (Annexure P-10).
