By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 99 dated 16.11.2015, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of IPC, at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar.

On 09.05.2017, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner was in Holand when he was declared P.O by the police. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is ready to join the proceedings and he will come to India within 15-20 days.

Notice of motion for 16.08.2017.

In the meantime, if the petitioner comes to India within a period of four weeks, he shall not be arrested and thereafter, he shall put in appearance before the trial Court

and submit his bail bonds and the trial Court shall accept the same.”

It is contended that in pursuance of order dated 09.05.2017, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has furnished bail/surety bonds.

The learned State counsel does not dispute the above said fact.

The learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that petitioner has been residing abroad and respondent No.2/wife is not being maintained. Respondent No.2 has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C., however, till date no amount has so far been paid.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 09.05.2017, is made absolute. The petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court and shall not leave the country without permission of this Court.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
