The petitioner is a lady, who was allegedly found in possession of 1266 grams of *sulpha*, which on analysis was found to be *charas*.

As a reformative measure, particularly in view of status of the petitioner being widow having two minor children, this Court enlarged the petitioner on interim bail, initially for six months, vide order dated 30.05.2016. Thereafter, the said order was made operative, vide order dated 30.11.2016.

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar submits that 03.04.2017 is the date fixed before

the trial Court for final arguments.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner shall appear on each and every date till conclusion of the trial before the trial Court.

In view of the aforesaid, the interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court shall remain in operation till conclusion of the trial, provided the petitioner appears on each and every date fixed before the trial Court.

If any default is committed, the trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel the interim bail so granted by this Court.
