Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.22 dated 20.02.2016 registered under Section 420/34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Nangal, District Ropar, on the basis of compromise dated 05.05.2016 (Annexure-P2).

Vide orders dated 18.05.2016, 11.08.2016 and 21.02.2017, passed by co-ordinate Benches of this Court, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib, on 28.02.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide letter bearing No.64 dated 04.03.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Rupnagar vide Endst. No.2286 dated 06.03.2017.

According to the report of Sub Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib, the parties had entered into compromise voluntarily, without any undue influence, pressure and coercion from any side and complainants Suresh Kumar @ Bholi and Vishal Sekhri had admitted the compromise voluntarily.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.22, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
