Petitioner who has faced incarceration since 14.02.2017, has filed the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.0488 dated 31.12.2016, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Sections 7 & 13 (1) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal, Haryana.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that co-accused Jaipal and against whom there were similar allegations, has been granted benefit of bail in the light of order dated 08.05.2017, passed by this Court in CRM-M-12878 of 2017.

On the ground of parity itself and for the same reasoning as adopted in the order dated 08.05.2017, passed by

this Court in CRM-M-12878 of 2017, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.
