Petitioner filed the present writ petition under Article 226 read with 227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction in the nature of certiorary quashing the orders passed by respondent No.1 dated 18.8.2000 (Annexure P-3). Further prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to direct respondent No.2 to pay provident fund on all the wages increased as per the Memorandum of Settlement dated 11.2.1997 arrived at between the petitioner and respondent No.2 due to the interference of Assistant Labour Commissioner-cum-Conciliation Officer, Rajpura.

Today an application under Section 151 of the CPC has been filed for permission to withdraw the abovesaid case as per the compromise dated 17.8.2003. Copy of the Memorandum of settlement executed on 17.8.2003 (Annexure A-1) has been annexed with the application. Copy of the Resolution dated 20.8.2017 and the Resolution for appointing the present committee in this regard are Annexures A-2 and A-3. Further copy

of affidavit of the office bearers collectively (Annexure A-4) has also been placed on record. Accordingly it has been prayed by learned counsel representing the petitioner that the petition be dismissed as withdrawn. Learned counsel representing the respondent has no objection to the prayer made.

In view of the above position and prayer made, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
