Petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.156 dated 09.02.2016, under Sections 302, 34, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Gurgaon. The petitioner was arrested on 16.03.2016 and is in jail since then.

I have seen the evidence of witnesses recorded before the trial Court. Prima-facie, there is no evidence against the present petitioner-Krishna.
