Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR No.407 dated 12.08.2013 has already been quashed by this Court vide order dated 19.05.2017 passed in *CRM-M-10877-2017* qua the other petitioners in that petitioner. However the present petitioner could not file the petition at that time. Therefore, the petitioner has now filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.407 dated 12.08.2013 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 406, 506 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 5, District Gurgaon, in view of compromise.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jai Singh Yadav, Advocate, who is present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the complainant.

On the asking of the Court Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana also accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel appearing for complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 30.03.2017 in *CRM-M-10877-2017* asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly, statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report had been received by this Court in *CRM-M-10877-2017* in which the present FIR has already been quashed qua the petitioners therein. In view of the judgment in that case and looking to the nature of the offence I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed qua the present petitioner also.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-16306 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.407 dated 12.08.2013 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 406, 506 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 5, District Gurgaon, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings, qua petitioner-Ashok as well.
