On 10.05.2017, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is ready to settle the issue with the complainant.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is ready to pay an amount of Rs.5 lacs by way of demand draft in favour of the complainant within two weeks. In the event of submitting demand draft in the sum of Rs.5 lacs to the Investigating Officer within two weeks, the petitioner shall be admitted to bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction. The Investigating Officer shall hand over the

demand draft to the complainant.

However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the aforesaid payment is only for deciding the anticipatory bail at this stage.
