By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in complaint No.5452 of 2015 dated 28.07.2015, filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Contentends that the absence before the trial Court is not wilful and deliberate. The petitioner bonafidely noted down the incorrect date as 02.03.2017 instead of 02.01.2017. Earlier the petitioner had been regularly appearing and never misused the concession of bail.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete set of paperbook has been handed over to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Heard.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of and the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court, within a week from today, and furnish bail bonds/surety bonds; an affidavit to the extent that no lapse in future on his part will take place; and subject to payment of Rs.10,000/- paid to the complainant as costs. In the event of his doing so, he shall be admitted to bail by the trial Court, to its satisfaction.
