**RITU BAHRI, J. (ORAL)**

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0005 dated 08.02.2017 under Sections 376(2)(n), 406, 506 IPC (Section 313 IPS added later on, but again deleted after further investigation on 21.03.2017) registered at Women Police Station, Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra.

The petitioner is in custody since 09.02.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant is a married lady having four children. She is residing with her husband and children. The petitioner is also a married person having two children.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that all the prosecution witnesses have already been examined before the trial Court.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this

petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kurukshetra.
