Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that pursuant to the order dated 20.01.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation. However, he submits that there were five other cases of similar nature registered against the petitioner, in four of which she has been acquitted and in one case the investigation is still going on and she has been granted concession of anticipatory bail in that case.

In view of the above and considering the fact that the petitioner has not been arrested at the spot and has been acquitted in four out of the five cases registered against her, and has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail in the fifth case also, the order dated 20.01.2017, granting

her anticipatory bail, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
