Petitioner is an accused of offences under Sections 379-A, 411 IPC registered at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

The allegations are that the petitioner is the purchaser of stolen goods/articles.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh states that the petitioner is also involved in four other cases, but he is on bail in those cases.

Challan has already been presented. Charges have been framed and the case is fixed for prosecution evidence on

20.05.2017. Petitioner is in custody since 26.01.2017.

In view of the allegations and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
