By filing the second bail petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.214, dated 21.12.2015, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana City.

The learned Senior counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. She has neither signed nor submitted any document before any authority for preparing birth certificate of her son, Jaskeerat Singh. Therefore, no role is attributed to the petitioner.

I have heard the learned counsel and carefully perused the entire record on file.

This is the second bail application of the petitioner. The first

was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 11.07.2016. The Court feels that no favourable circumstances have emerged during the interregnum period. In fact the FIR was registered on 21.12.2015, the petitioner has successfully evaded the process of Court despite the fact that his bail application was dismissed way back on 11.07.2016.

Dismissed.
