**SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)**

1. In this petition, the petitioner, who is accused person in FIR No.294 dated 17.04.2015 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 & 120-B at Police Station City Yamunanagar, has prayed for quashing of FIR with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

2. Earlier vide order dated 19.05.2016, this Court had referred the matter to Ld. trial Court for the purpose of verifying the factum of compromise relied upon by the petitioner. Report of Ld. Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Yamunanagar, dated 29.07.2016 has since been received along with copies of the statements of the parties recorded by him, and from which it transpires that the dispute between them arising out of the alleged occurrence/offences has since been amicably compromised.

*Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543* and *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping the criminal proceedings pending since the victim has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioner/accused person and has furnished an affidavit to this effect.

4. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.294 dated 17.04.2015 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 & 120-B at Police Station City Yamunanagar (Annexure P-1), with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, is hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
