By filing the present petition under Section 439 read with Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought interim bail for six months in FIR No.55 dated 02.08.2013, registered under Sections 21 & 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act'), at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, District Tarn Taran.

The interim bail is sought on the ground that minor son of the petitioner is suffering from urinary tract infection

(UTI) and doctor has advised surgery to him. The petitioner was earlier admitted to interim bail for the said purpose and he did not misuse the concession of the same.

The learned State counsel, on instructions duly acknowledges the above said fact.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of six weeks from the date of his release on his furnishing requisite bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned. The date to surrender is to be indicated by the releasing Court.
