Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No. 194, dated 21.05.2013, under Sections 148, 149, 332, 353, 186, 307, 201 and 120-B I.P.C. and under Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Shivaji Colony, Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Out of total twelve accused persons involved in the case, Ravi has expired because of gun shot injury at the time of occurrence only. The accused persons, namely Ramesh, Shamsher, Rahul, Jaibir @ Tinu, Dinesh @ Nesha, Sandeep and Sunil, have been granted bail by the High Court and co-accused Anil has been granted bail by the trial Court.

The petitioner has not been named in the F.I.R. He was arrested in some other case and thereafter, he was arrested in the present case on production warrants on 12.07.2016.

Learned State counsel on instructions from A.S.I. Vinod Kumar submitted that after filing of challan, 24 prosecution witnesses have been examined, out of total 47 prosecution witnesses. Nothing has been recovered from the petitioner.

Having considered the submissions, I find that the case of the petitioner appears to be at par with Ramesh, Shamsher, Rahul and Jaibir.

At this stage, without adverting to merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
