Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.328 dated 15.04.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Ballabgarh City, District Faridabad, on the basis of compromise dated 26.04.2017/03.05.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate on 25.05.2017 to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

In compliance of the order dated 11.05.2017 of this Court, the

parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad on

25.05.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide his covering letter No.702 dated 26.05.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Faridabad vide letter No.9505 dated 30.05.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, the compromise between the parties is voluntary, without any threat, pressure, undue influence or fraud.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.328, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
