By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.645, dated 22.11.2010, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Central Faridabad.

Contents that similarly placed co-accused, Rajiv Gambhir, has been granted the relief sought. He states that the petitioner could not attend the Court proceedings on 03.02.2017 as he was in important business meetings in Kolkata and Guwahati.

Heard.

The case of the petitioner is not at par with said co-accused Rajiv Gambhir as in his (Rajiv Gambhir) case, he could not appear because of certain personal reasons. Whereas, the petitioner knowing fully well chose to attend the official meetings instead of Court proceedings. In these circumstances, this Court feels that there is no priority in the mind of the petitioner for the Court proceedings.

Dismissed.
