INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Sohan Lal alias Sonu has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.80 dated 13.08.2014, registered at Police Station Sadar SBS Nagar, under Sections 15 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 or in the alternative for issuance of direction to the trial court to expedite the trial and conclude it at the earliest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer to the extent that trial Court may be directed to expedite the trial of the case.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

Since learned counsel for the petitioner has not pressed this petition in respect of quashing of the aforesaid FIR, therefore, this petition is dismissed to this extent.

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So far as alternative prayer for expeditious disposal of the case is concerned, I find that FIR was registered on 13.08.2014 and the petitioner is already on bail.

As such, no ground is made out to issue such direction also.
