Quashing of FIR No. 07 dated 04.03.2017, under Sections 376/313/450/506/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station, Women Cell, SAS Nagar (Mohali) (Annexure P-1) is sought on the basis of compromise effected between the parties.

The F.I.R was registered on the basis of complaint made by Anchal-complainant (respondent No.2) to the effect that she was a student of BDS in B.R.S. Dental College, Barwala, where she came in contact with Satinder alias Pintu-petitioner No.1 and developed a friendly relations with him. However, he (petitioner No.1) sexually exploited the complainant on the pretext of marriage. Ultimately, he refused to solemnize marriage with the complainant. In this background, the FIR was registered.

After registration of the FIR, with the intervention of respectable persons, the matter has now been amicably resolved between the parties. As per compromise, petitioner No.1 has undertaken to solemnize marriage with respondent No.2-complainant after completion of her studies.

In compliance with the order dated 11.05.2017 passed by this Court, parties have got recorded their statements before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate. Report dated 25.05.2017 from the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, SAS Nagar (Mohali), has been received in this regard. As per report, Anchal-respondent No.2 (complainant) made her statement on 20.05.2017 to the effect that with the intervention of respectable persons, she has compromised the matter with accused-petitioners out of her own free will and without any coercion or pressure. She has no objection if, the aforesaid FIR is quashed. Jai Devi-respondent No.3, mother of Anchal-complainant, has also got recorded her statement, whereby she has admitted the factum of compromise between the parties. Separate statements of Satinder alias Pintu and Balwan Singh-petitioners were also recorded to the same effect. In view of separate statements given by the parties, the court is satisfied that the compromise is valid and genuine one.

Consequently, in view of the status report and the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (CrI.) 1052**, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No. 07 dated 04.03.2017, under Sections 376/313/450/506/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station, Women Cell, SAS

Nagar (Mohali), is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
