ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.48 dated 05.03.2017 under Sections 406/420/466/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District S.A.S Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on the basis of sale deed dated 11.07.2011, mutation No.39380 was sanctioned on 09.03.2017 which is a genuine mutation. The alleged preparation of *Jamabandi* on the basis of correct mutation is not relatable to any act of the petitioner.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 26.05.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-

interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sikander Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 26.05.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 26.05.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
