Petitioner was involved in the offence under Sections 380, 411 IPC, when he was caught red-handed while cutting the copper pipe of AC installed in the High Court premises.

Petitioner was granted bail by the trial Court. Thereafter he absented from the trial Court. Non-bailable warrants were issued on 26.10.2015 and the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed person. No effort was made by the petitioner after 21.10.2015 to join the proceedings.

In view of above, no indulgence can be granted under Section 438 Cr.P.C., however petitioner is at liberty to appear and surrender before the trial Court. In the event of his

surrender before the trial Court and filing an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided in accordance with law within a period of three days.

Petition stands dismissed with the aforesaid liberty.
