Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.177 dated 22.05.2016, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act') (Section 27-A of the NDPS Act, Section 7/9 & 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and Sections 166A, 180, 384 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 added later on), registered at Police Station Madlauda, District Panipat. The petitioner was arrested and is in jail.

In view of the reasons stated in order dated 06.10.2016 passed in CRM-M-30480 of 2016, this petition is allowed.
