The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.147 dated 26.04.2017, for the offence under Sections 363, 366A IPC and Section 16 of POCSO Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Firozpur Jhirka, on the basis of the petitioner had solemnized marriage with daughter of respondent No.3/complainant.

It is alleged by the complainant that her daughter Asmeena aged 16-17 years old had ran away with a person of her village. On getting this information, complainant could not find his daughter and in this backdrop, present FIR has been registered.

Petitioner No.1 and his wife filed a petition i.e. CRM-M-15371 of 2017 before this Court for protection of their live and liberty and vide order dated 02.05.2017 (Annexure P-2), they have been granted protection for their lives and liberties. The date of birth of the daughter of the complainant

present in Court today with his wife Asmeena who was identified by ASI Ramesh Chander, Inquiry Officer. On a specific query, Asmeena has told that she is happily residing with her husband.

Keeping in view, Asmeena-wife of the petitioner-Insaf has attained majority and she is residing with her husband happily, as such, FIR No.147 dated 26.04.2017, for the offence under Sections 363, 366A IPC and Section 16 of POCSO Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Firozpur Jhirka (Annexure P-1), is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
