This petition for grant of regular bail has been moved by Joginder Singh an accused in FIR No.02 dated 25.02.2015 for offences under Sections 18, 21, 25, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985. The quantity of contraband recovered in this case happens to be 50 kgs of heroin out of that 10 kgs. was recovered from petitioner – Joginder Singh along with 250 grams of opium was also recovered from him.

In view of the heavy quantity of recovered contraband and bar of Section 37 NDPS Act, no ground for grant of regular bail to the petitioner

is made out. The petition in that way stands dismissed.

However, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments.
