The sole grievance of the petitioner is that a charge under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code (in short "IPC") has been framed against the accused pertaining to FIR No. 88 dated 29.12.2015. In those proceedings, the petitioner/complainant filed an application for framing of charge under Section 406 IPC but the same has not been disposed of despite the fact that the application is pending for the past about nine months.

Without examining merits of the controversy, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the trial court to dispose of the application within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, in accordance with law.
