Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos4 and 5 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 08.05.2017 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the representation dated 08.05.2017 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2, to look into the representation dated 08.05.2017 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
