Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint No.10RT 16.03.2011/21.04.2016
under Sections 409, 406, 418, 166, 167, 217, 218, 201, 203 and 120-B IPC.

Notice of motion was issued. Respondent No.1-in person and
learned State counsel appeared and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent
No.1-in person as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the
record.

The perusal of the record shows that petitioners are summoned
by the trial Court and they are only to face trial.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find it a fit case, where petitioners are entitled to benefit of anticipatory bail. Therefore, present petition is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest by the Court in the complaint case, they shall be released on bail.
