Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the complaint filed by the petitioner, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, against respondents no.1 to 3, has been lingering before the trial Court for the past 5 years, i.e. since March 2012, however, now the trial Court has concluded the evidence of the complainant and the matter has been fixed for hearing on 22.05.2017, for recording the statements of the respondent-accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to ensure that the trial is concluded at the very earliest and in any case before 31.07.2017.
