The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.76 dated 25.4.2016 under Section 306/34 IPC, Police Station Division No.8, District Jalandhar in view of compromise.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 12.5.2017 asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly, statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court. Looking to the report it is seen that the compromise is voluntary and genuine. I have seen the offences registered against the petitioner. Looking to the nature of the offence I think the compromise should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRM-M-16742 of 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) FIR No.76 dated 25.4.2016 under Section 306/34 IPC, Police Station Division No.8, District Jalandhar is quashed, qua the petitioners.
