Present petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to petitioner, namely Jagjit Singh alias Laddi in case FIR No.6 dated 26.04.2014 under Sections 21, 25, 29, 61, 85 of NDPS, Act registered at Police Station SSOC, District Amritsar. However, learned counsel for the petitioner restricted his prayer for release of the petitioner on interim bail for a period of four weeks for getting treatment of his wife, who is suffering from Kidney problem and required for kidney transplantation. As per petitioner there is no other adult member in the family to look after his ailing wife.

Learned State counsel has placed on file reply, which is taken on record. The factum of illness is admitted by the State.

In view of the above facts, present petition is accepted and petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of four weeks so as to enable him to look after his ailing wife, on his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.

Nothing said here-in-above shall be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
