Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.0292 dated 12.07.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 120-B, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused has been granted bail.

I have perused nature of the injury considering which the bail has been granted to the co-accused. It is clear from the perusal of the FIR and the medical report that the main grievous injury was caused by the petitioner-Inderjit Singh @ MP on head and not by the other accused and that is why, he was granted bail. Petitioner's case cannot be compared on parity basis with the others.

In that view of the matter, this petition stands dismissed.

Pursuance to the last orders made by this Court, there is explanation from the Additional District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar. The same is found satisfactory and filed, accordingly.
