Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.21, dated 03.03.2015, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Valtoha, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is 260 grams of contraband. Report of the Chemical Examiner has since been received and which shows the salt of alprazolam. Such recovery would be construed as commercial in nature.

Accordingly, the prayer for regular bail to the petitioner is declined.

Petition is dismissed.
