

that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded, which indicates that they have entered into compromise voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

Only simple injuries are stated to have been caused in the incident and the parties want to put quietus to the litigation. In view the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 2, dated 05.01.2017, under Sections 379, 451, 342, 323, 427, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Moga and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
