Petitioners seek grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No. 15, dated 18.03.2017, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B I.P.C., registered at Police Station Kanwan, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners stated that the controversy relates to offence under Sections 420, 467, 468,

471 and 120-B I.P.C. and the same has been settled between the accused and the complainant.

The aforesaid fact has been admitted by learned State counsel on instructions from A.S.I. Tarsem Singh as well as by learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No. 2 and 3.

Keeping in view the nature of offence and the compromise effected between the parties, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioners on regular bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on regular bail, subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
