Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.28 dated 28.02.2017, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural. The petitioner was arrested on 28.02.2017 and is in jail since then.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official states that there is no other case against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that there is no other case against the petitioner and looking to the date of his arrest, I am inclined to grant him bail.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed.

Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the

file undertaking before the trial Court that he will not indulge in similar or any other kind of offence in future. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
