Following is the prayer in the present petition:

“Petition U/s 482 Cr. P. C. for directing the respondent no.2 to conduct the investigation in the FIRs (Annexure P-1 to P-8) and other unknown FIRs which have been got registered against the sons of the petitioners by appointing some senior officers or under their direct supervision in a fair and transparent manner in order to ascertain the veracity of the allegations leveled against the sons of the petitioners.”

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

There is response filed to the petition by Sh Harkamal Preet Singh Khakh, PPS, Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural). The reply shows that the sons of the petitioners namely Balwinder Singh and Sarabjit Singh @ Manga have been involved in large number of criminal cases. The details have been furnished in the reply. Following is the list:

1. FIR No.153 dated 05.12.2014 registered under Sections 399 & 402 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Lohia, District Jalandhar.

2. FIR No.138 dated 09.10.2014 registered under Sections 457 & 380 IPC at Police Station Lohia, District Jalandhar.
3. FIR No.118 dated 16.08.2014 registered under Sections 454 & 380 IPC at Police Station Lohia, District Jalandhar.
4. FIR No.8 dated 01.03.2014 registered under Sections 457, 380 & 411 IPC at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.
5. FIR No.121 dated 23.08.2014 registered under Section 379 IPC at Police Station Lohia, District Jalandhar at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.
6. FIR No.121 dated 09.06.2014 registered under Sections 454 & 380 IPC at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar.
7. FIR No.194 dated 06.10.2014 registered under Section 379 IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.
8. FIR No.101 dated 15.05.2014 registered under Sections 457 & 380 IPC at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Looking to the above criminal cases registered against the sons of the petitioners, this Court does not think that the prayer made by the petitioners can be entertained.

In the light of the above discussion, I find no merit in the petition. The petition is, therefore, dismissed.
