INDERJIT SINGH, J.

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to transfer/handover the investigation in case FIR No.217 dated 13.09.2016, under Section 409 IPC, Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala (Annexure P-1) to some senior police officer of another district or to some independent investigating agency as the local police is not taking any action against respondent No.5 and also the police has failed to arrest respondent No.5, even after a period of 6 months of registration of FIR (P-1) and is helping respondent No.5 in every possible manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer that his representation (Annexure P-5) may be considered by the Superintendent of Police, Ambala, as per law.
